NGEMC Howard Baker Memorial Scholarship Information

Eligibility:

What are the eligibility requirements for the NGEMC/TVA Howard Baker Memorial Scholarship?

- Must be a graduating high school senior.
- Must reside in household with electricity served by NGEMC.
- Must be enrolled in a full-time, accredited program attending high school in the county in which he/she resides.
- Must be accepted by an accredited two- or four-year technical school, college, or university.
- Must complete the NGEMC Howard Baker Memorial Scholarship application fully.
- Must not have received a full scholarship from any other source.

Please read the instructions carefully and entirely before finishing the application form.

- Application Deadline: The application will be due **January 16, 2009** at the Dalton NGEMC office to the following address:

- Application Package: The completed scholarship application must include the following:
 1. A properly completed application form
 2. A resume highlighting your future goals, scholastic achievements, school associations, and community involvement.
 3. A two-to-three page typed essay related to electricity
 4. College acceptance letter (if available)
 5. High school transcript
 6. Most recent ACT or SAT score
 7. Two letters of recommendation
 8. Two color photographs (Photos of the winners will be used for publicity purposes)
- Essay: Electricity is one of the most important discoveries of all time. You must write a two-to-three page, double-spaced, typed, essay about electricity. Feel free to expand on the electric industry, energy conservation, what electricity means to you, etc. Be creative!
- Letters of Recommendation: Two signed letters of recommendation must accompany your application. The letters must be from individuals who are familiar with your academic and leadership abilities.

General Information:

- *How much is the scholarship worth?*

The scholarship is a one-time, \$1,000 award with funds paid by NGEMC in the form of a check to the accredited college, university, or technical school attended by the recipient. One high school senior from each of the seven counties served by NGEMC will win.

- *What expenses may be covered by scholarship?*

The award will be applied towards tuition, books, academic fees, and/or housing.

- *When must the scholarship be used?*

The money awarded to the student must be used within one year of its issuance and be entirely utilized within two years of the date of its issuance. Any unused funds will be returned by the school to NGEMC's Dalton office.

- *Are NGEMC employee's children eligible for the Howard Baker Scholarship?*

Absolutely not. No student that resides within the home of an NGEMC employee is eligible.

- *How will the winners be determined?*

A group of non-biased judges will choose winners based on the student's academic achievements, scholastic

success, and their school and community involvement.
