QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: (Applicants must meet the minimum requirements for the position by closing date of this vacancy announcement)

Purpose:

To perform line service maintenance and construction functions; to provide a high level of line construction and operations knowledge.

Minimum Qualifications:

- High School Diploma/Equivalent
- Minimum of one year's experience as a Line Worker/Service Worker Level 4 or Journeyman Lineworker Certification issued through the TVPPA or equivalent certification and position availability.
- Have and maintain a valid Georgia commercial driver's license (Class A) and DOT certification.

Job Functions:

- Demonstrates proficiency in ascending and descending poles and other structures.
- Safely operates and maintains company cars, trucks and other equipment.
- Ensures that assigned tools and working equipment are properly used and kept in good working condition and that any required repairs are promptly reported to the immediate supervisor.
- Keeps vehicles clean, orderly, and serviced according to manufacturer recommendations.
- Keeps vehicle stocked with appropriate material.
- Makes all types of single and polyphase transformer installations, rephasing and phase rotation on polyphase circuits.
- Installs, moves, and removes transformers, outdoor lighting, secondaries, service drops,

- OCB's, VWVE's, poles, conductors, capacitors, regulators or any other line equipment.
- Installs or removes instrument transformers, recording or indicating meters of all types; makes load and voltage tests.
 - Patrols transmission and distribution lines; operates and maintains related equipment; learns distribution switching, sectionalizing and fusing.
 - Properly operates radio equipment.
 - Submits time, mileage, gas tickets, material charge-outs and credit-ins; other required forms.
 - Ensures explosives for blasting are handling in accordance with designated safety precautions, as required.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

All requirements are subject to possible modification to reasonably accommodate individuals with disabilities (some requirements may exclude individuals who pose a direct threat or significant risk to the health and safety of themselves or other employees.) Require physical ability in climbing, balancing, stooping, pushing, pulling, crouching, crawling, reaching, standing, walking, lifting, the ability to lift small objects with the fingers, grasping, talking, hearing, and defined heavy work. Visual acuity required as machine operator and as mobile equipment operators. Adverse weather conditions.

WORKING CONDITIONS:

Field work with exposure to adverse elements of weather; strenuous physical work, including heavy lifting; require flexibility to work overtime and irregular hours on short notice. Requires the flexibility to work during emergency situations. Requires the flexibility to be on-call, as required.

Candidates meeting the minimum qualification requirements for this position may be further evaluated against other job related factors to determine who will be referred to the selecting Cooperative Vice President. The rating and ranking of candidates to determine the best qualified will be accomplished by comparing the candidate's knowledge, skills, and abilities against those of other eligible candidates for each of the evaluation factors. The candidate's experience, training, awards, and other candidate provided documentation will be considered in the evaluation process. It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide all of the information needed by the closing date of this announcement and to bring all applicable information to an interview, if scheduled.
