Factors to consider when searching for an electrician:

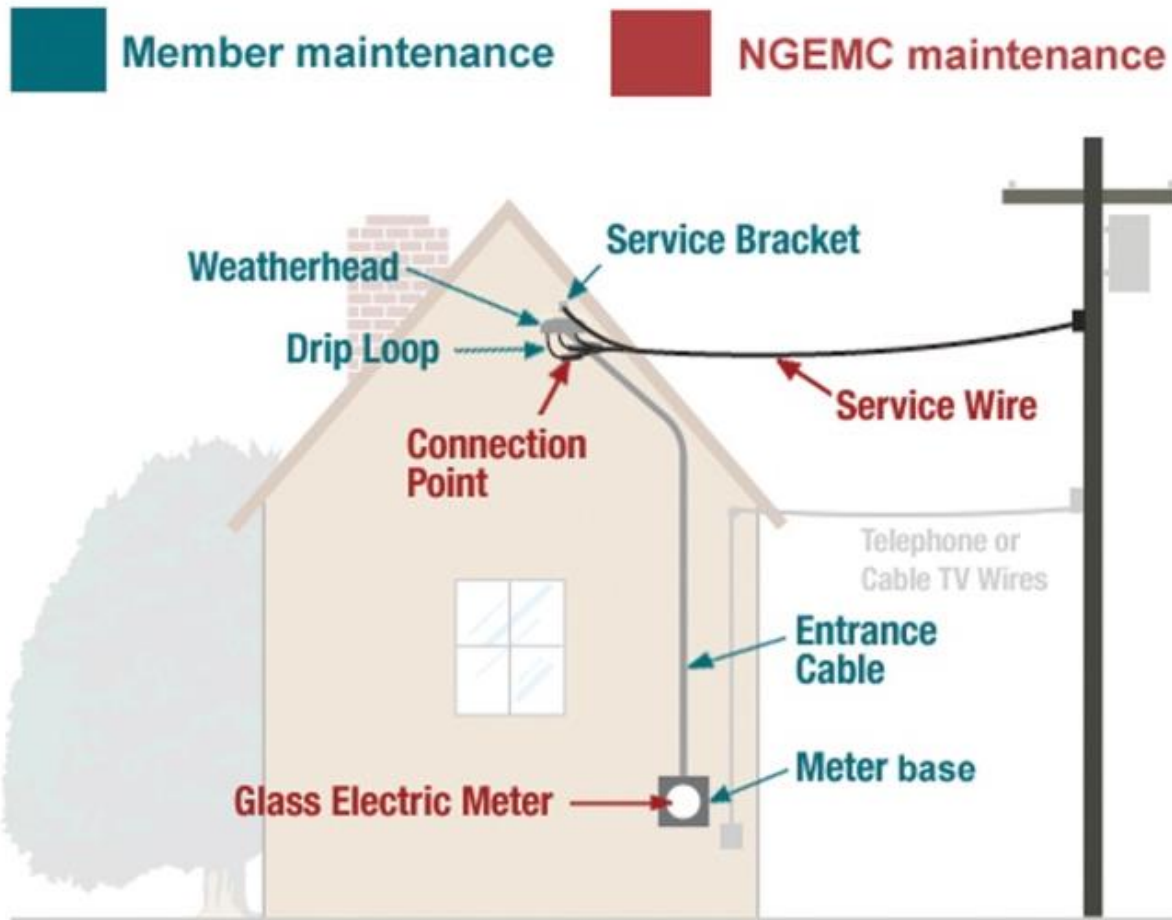
- Obtain cost estimates from multiple contractors.
- Ensure proof of state license, liability insurance and workers compensation coverage (minimum coverage amount of \$500,000 is recommended for residential contractors).
- Request a list of references.
- Discuss permitting, code and inspection requirements mandated by local code enforcement officials.
- Determine additional fees, if any, for after-hours service.

Understanding your home's electrical service



The graphic above shows which electric service components at your home are maintained by NGEMC and which are maintained by you the member. For your safety, please remember the following:

- Always use a licensed electrician when making electrical repairs to your home.
- Do not pull your own meter, and do not allow an electrician to pull your meter when making repairs. **Only NGEMC certified employees are permitted to pull electric meters.**
- Call NGEMC to schedule a disconnect for electrical repairs, structure repairs and tree removal.

Reporting power outages

Things to remember

- NGEMC's Automated Metering Infrastructure is designed to detect outage locations.
- First, check your breaker before calling to report outages.
- To report outages, use the **My NGEMC Mobile App** for Android® and iPhone® devices. Phone lines may be busy during widespread outages.
